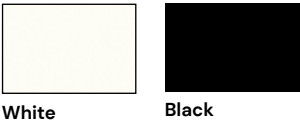

# Cleaning & Maintenance

## GENERAL MAINTENANCE

- Most hard surfaces can be cleaned with a soft cloth, dampened with a small amount of water and buffed dry.
- Clean spills and drips quickly to prevent them marking.
- Never drag any objects accross tabletop surfaces as these can leave surface scratches.
- Although tabletop surfaces are resistand to a degree of heat & liquids, we would always recommend the use of coasters as an additional protection.

## LAMINATE SURFACES

Clean surfaces regularly with a slightly damp cloth and a mild solution of soapy water. Buff dry with a soft duster.

## POWDER COATED METAL SURFACES

Clean surfaces regularly with a slightly damp cloth and a mild solution of soapy water. Buff dry with a soft duster.

## NATURAL FABRICS

In addition to regular vacuuming, wool and other natura fibres can usually be cleaned using appropriate upholstery shampoo. For a deeper clean it is best that wool be dry cleaned, as over-wetting can cause shrinkage and appearance change. Never apply bleach, ammonia, alkali or strong acids to wool upholstery.

## SYNTHETIC FABRICS

Vacuuming is the best regular maintenance followed by speed of action to remove spills and stains rapidly as soon as they occur. Most synthetic fabrics can be wiped down with a water soaked damp cloth without fear of damaging fibre or removing colour. Stubborn stains can be removed with a quality upholstery shampoo.

## LEATHER

Leather should be regularly dusted with a soft cloth and vacuumed with a soft brush extension. Most types of aniline can also be treated with specialist products to help preserve colour/finish etc. As leather is a natural material, discrepancies in surface texture and 'puddling' in seat areas is to be expected.
