

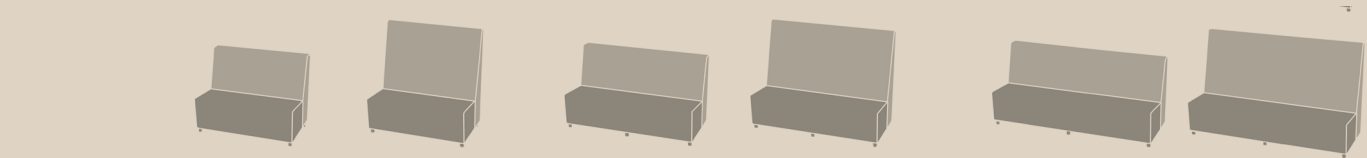

WALL PANELS

Upholstered Wall Panels can be fixed to walls above **Tolv** benches to create a higher back and a more built-in aesthetic.

Custom widths up to **1200mm** and **1600mm** wide can be produced at no additional cost.

CUSTOM SIZING

Benches can be modified to any width, up to **1200mm** wide or **1600mm** wide. Choose the closest size that exceeds your requirements out of the width options above.

A one-off charge applies per size modification.
For custom width Wall Panels there is no addition charge.

EXPOSED BACKS

Standard **Tolv** benches are designed to sit against a wall, and as such external backs are upholstered in a black lining cloth as standard. Should a fully upholstered backrest be required please specify.

PATTERNED FABRICS

Due to fabric widths any patterned fabrics on 1600mm versions will run along the width of the unit. If patterns need to run vertically down the unit additional charges may apply.

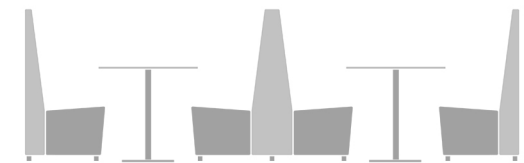
LINKING

Linking mechanisms will only be fitted to the units subject to layout plans being provided. Alternatively, mechanisms will be free-issued.



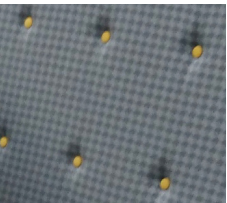
POWER
Porthole Power modules can be incorporated into seat fronts on request.

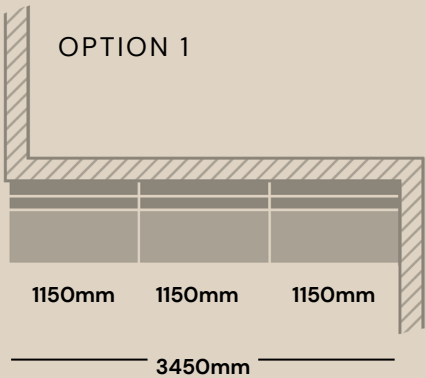

Straight Run

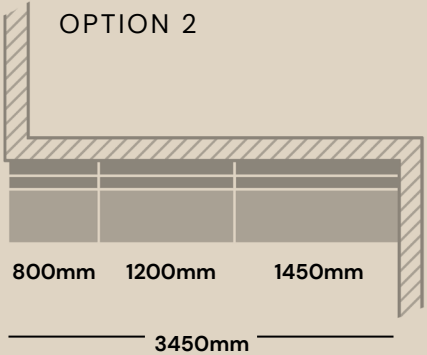
To create a bench running the length of a 3450mm wall, based on a Height of 900mm, in a Group 3 fabric, the following options can be created:

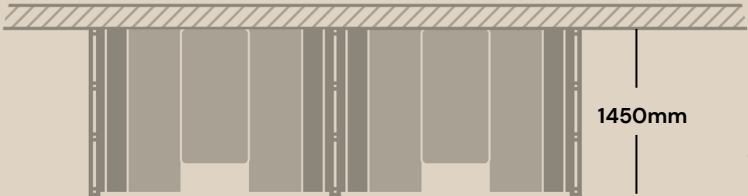

To create booth setups between stud-wall partitions, based on backrest heights of 1200mm, with additional upholstered wall panels mounted above, all in Group 3 fabric.

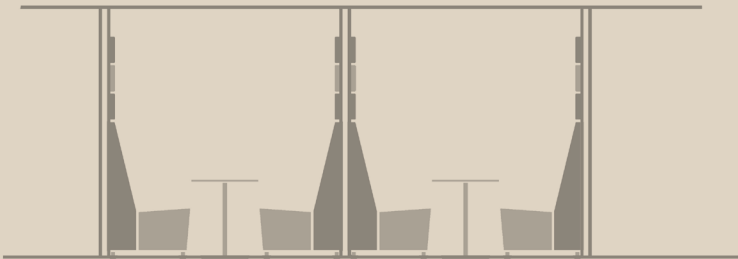

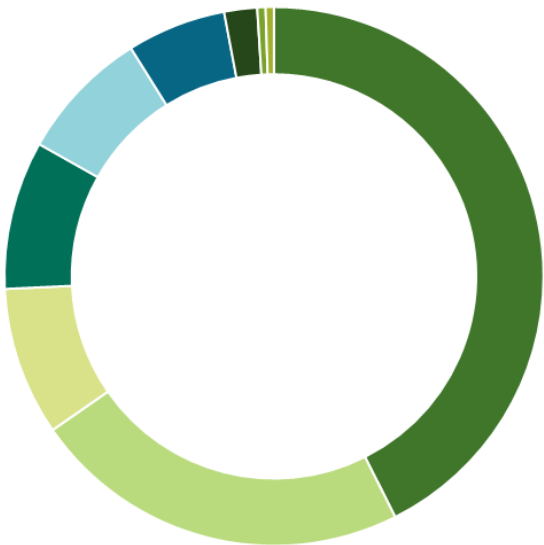

The foams & fillings of this product meet BS EN 5852: Part 2, in accordance with The Furniture and Furnishings (Fire) (Safety) Regulations 1988.

CONSTRUCTION

Designed to meet & exceed BS EN 16139: 2013 – Strength, Durability and Safety Requirements for non-domestic seating.

Cleaning & Maintenance

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

- Vacuum upholstery regularly to remove dust and grit.
- Most hard surfaces can be cleaned with a soft cloth, dampened with a small amount of water and buffed dry.
- Clean spills and stains quickly to prevent them setting in (see specific fabric care instructions below).
- If being used in a spill/stain prone area specify an appropriate finish with stain-repellent properties.

Refer to fabric manufacturers own guidelines for specific information.

NATURAL FABRICS

In addition to regular vacuuming, wool and other natura fibres can usually be cleaned using appropriate upholstery shampoo. For a deeper clean it is best that wool be dry cleaned, as over-wetting can cause shrinkage and appearance change. Never apply bleach, ammonia, alkali or strong acids to wool upholstery.

SYNTHETIC FABRICS

Vacuuming is the best regular maintenance followed by speed of action to remove spills and stains rapidly as soon as they occur. Most synthetic fabrics can be wiped down with a water soaked damp cloth without fear of damaging fibre or removing colour. Stubborn stains can be removed with a quality upholstery shampoo.

LEATHER

Leather should be regularly dusted with a soft cloth and vacuumed with a soft brush extension. Most types of aniline can also be treated with specialist products to help preserve colour/finish etc. As leather is a natural material, discrepancies in surface texture and 'puddling' in seat areas is to be expected.

LACQUERED & PAINTED

Clean surfaces regularly with a slightly damp cloth and a mild solution of soapy water. Buff dry with a soft duster.



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
